

## CITY CARSHARE RESIDENT BENEFITS

### ALL MINT COLLECTION RESIDENTS ENJOY EXCLUSIVE USE OF A MINI COOPER PARKED ON THE PREMISES.

*City CarShare is a Bay Area nonprofit that provides convenient, affordable access to a fleet of vehicles on an hourly basis in an effort to reduce individual car ownership, and improve the environment and quality of life in our cities.*

*Martin Building Company and City CarShare want to make getting to your destination easier, so we have made a special arrangement for all Mint Collection residents to enjoy exclusive use of a Mini Cooper parked on-site, in the Hales Warehouse garage. In addition, as a City CarShare member you will have access to any of City CarShare's 190 vehicles throughout the Bay Area's 100 locations.*

#### **Why is City CarShare membership so great?**

You have access to a variety of car types such as Prius hybrids, Mini Coopers, Scions, Elements, and pick-up trucks.

Car sharing also eliminates many of the costs associated with owning a car, including car payments, depreciation, registration, taxes, parking, insurance, maintenance, and gas. Now imagine what you can do with that extra money!

#### **Why is this special?**

Most of City CarShare (CCS) vehicles are available to more than 6,500 Bay Area members, but as a Mint Collection resident, you get exclusive use of a beautiful, shiny, black Mini Cooper on site. So, instead of sharing the Mini with 6,500 people, you only share with other residents.

#### **How do residents sign up?**

Simply fill out the Mint Collection Exclusive Use Membership form and return it to the Concierge. It is then forwarded to City CarShare, driving records are checked, and once cleared, membership is made official.

#### **How does it work?**

Members need to complete an online orientation, which just takes a just few minutes; you then receive a member number, password and electronic key fob. To start driving, just reserve your car online or by phone, grab your fob, jump in your car and go! It's that easy.

#### **How much does it cost to sign up?**

All fees are waived for Mint Collection residents, so you not have to pay the standard \$30 application fee, \$300 deposit or a \$10/month membership fee.

#### **How much does it cost to use a car?**

Cars are available on an hourly basis, and you only pay for the time you use the car. The standard driving rate is currently set at \$4/hour (and \$6/hour for the Mini) and 44 cents per mile. Insurance, gas, maintenance, cleaning and parking are included.

#### **How do residents access the cars?**

Reservations can be made easily online at [CityCarShare.org](http://CityCarShare.org) or by telephone. Cars are available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. There's no waiting in line and no pick-up and drop-off paperwork hassles.

#### **How do existing members switch to the Mint Collection membership?**

You just call 415.995.8588 and CCS will switch you to the Mint Collection membership. You will no longer need to pay the monthly fee (offer valid until April 1, 2009). And if you already have a deposit with City CarShare the deposit will be refunded as driving credits.

#### **Can members pick a car up at one location, and drop it off somewhere else?**

No. Each car is assigned its own space at its home location, so cars must be returned to the same location they were picked up from.

#### **How do most people use City CarShare cars?**

- Take the MINI out for grocery shopping trips.
- Pick up a Scion XB or pick-up truck for big errands.
- Take BART to the East Bay, pick up a car, and avoid bridge traffic.
- Get to business meetings in Silicon Valley or Marin without spending hours on transit.
- Airport pick-up and drop-offs.

#### **What if the resident has a foreign driving license?**

The resident must obtain a U.S. driver's license before applying to City CarShare.
